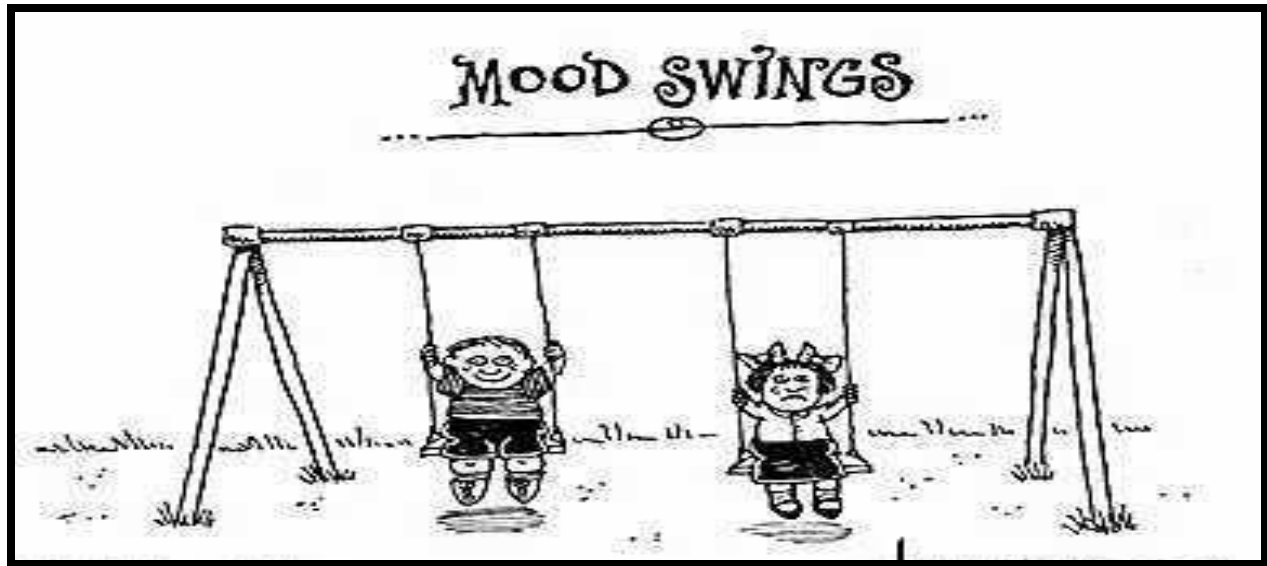


# ARE YOU FLUENT IN THE LANGUAGE OF EMOTION?
